“A Pleasant Perch”

On homesteads throughout southern Utah, the soft glow of kerosene lanterns lighted the night well into the ‘40’s.

This lantern – the “Air Pilot No.2” made by Embury Mfg. Co. – can no longer brighten a barn or home. Instead, it has become part of the landscape it once illuminated, settling into the sand, sagebrush and oak brush, and rusting as red as the bluffs.

Where weathered hands once lighted its wick, a migrating chickadee now finds it as a “Pleasant Perch.”
